READ: (Luke 9:18-27)

Q. Do you remember WHAT you wanted to be when you grew up and DID you ever get fulfil that dream or not?

Q. DID you ever feel under pressure to fulfil a dream that someone else had for you, and DID that motivate you or leave you cold?

(Vs.18-20)

Q. If Jesus asked you to say who He was to your friends or family, HOW might you best describe Him to them?

Q. HOW should Peter's answer (Vs.20) inform the way we are and act as a parent, friend, colleague, church member or does it not matter at all?

(Vs. 21-22)

It has been argued that "*Gospel possession requires gospel proclamation.*"

Q. WHY was Jesus so keen not to have His disciples tell anyone at this point who He was then?

Q. IS the timing of our gospel proclamation on our own frontlines at home and elsewhere, just as important as the telling?

(Vs.23-24)

Q. From these verses discuss HOW do we grow up to become a faithful and fruitful disciple of the Lord?

Q. In WHAT ways might we try to save our lives and end up losing it as Jesus predicts?

(Vs.25-27)

Q. WHAT are the main idols, sins, and comforts in this world right now do you think that most threatens us with shame should the Lord return for us today?

Q. HOW should our growing up to be a true disciple of Jesus better help us to raise our children and share the life-giving message of Jesus ourselves?

READ: (Philippians 3:12-14)

Q. With so much growing up still to do WHAT are we still dreaming of growing up to become in the Lord and for the Lord while there is still time?
