(Isaiah 9:6-7) **CHRISTMAS DELIVERY: TRACKED:**A PROPHECY TO DELIVER

The word Advent means arrival or coming into place.

- Q. Share HOW you personally prepare for Christmas?
- Q. WHAT are the Christmas traditions you look forward to each year that help you to prepare for Christmas? We are TRACKING through these verses in Isaiah the coming of Jesus as God's greatest Christmas Delivery.
- Q. IS there anything you like to keep track of and WHY?
- Q. HAS there ever been anything you should have kept track of and didn't, and if so, WHAT resulted from it?

(Vs.6)

- **Q.** WHAT is the difference here between a child born and a son given?
- Q. WHAT do you think is meant by "the government will be on His shoulders" and HOW uplifting is it?
- Q. HOW important are the names given Jesus here and in WHAT ways does He live up to them?
- Q. (Matthew 1:22) underlines that this verse is tracking the promise of the coming messiah, but HOW does (Isaiah 7:14 and Matthew 1:23) add confirmation to this idea?

(Vs.7)

- **Q.** WHAT kind of kingdom is this verse speaking of and HOW is it different from all other kingdoms known to us?
- **Q.** HOW is this kingdom formed, WHAT does it mean, and HOW long is it going to last.

- Q. HOW might (Matthew 2:2 and Revelation 19:16) help to reassure us that the king in the manger is greater than any king that has been or will ever be?
- **Q.** WHAT difference should the kingship of Jesus make to our lives today?
- Q. WHAT might we need to be TRACKING in our lives to make sure that Christ is not lost to Christmas for us? (There is still room in the inn of our life for Him.)
