

**A PEOPLE PLEASING TO GOD:

(Revelation 2:18-29)**

Q. HAS there ever been a time WHEN for the sake of your own popularity, advancement, or path of least resistance, you were happy to tolerate someone or something you would not have normally tolerated?

Q. WHAT do you think tolerance means and WHAT is the difference, if any, between tolerance and love?

(Vs.18)

Q. WHAT do you think Jesus' "*eyes of fire*" and "*feet of burnished bronze*" tells us about Christ here? Consider (Vs.23b) as well.

(Vs.19)

Q. In WHAT ways did Christ commend Thyatira, and are we still progressing like them in these areas?

(Vs.20-23)

Q. WHAT is the Jezebel spirit and HOW do you think it still invades the church today? (1 Kings 16:31,18:13)

Q. HOW do we keep our allegiance to Christ alone?

Q. In WHAT ways might you see the Christian faith being watered down today, and in the light of what Jesus is telling the church at Thyatira that He will do, because of that Jezebel spirit, HOW seriously ought we to take false teaching and sexual immorality in the Church?

Q. WHAT might Jesus be giving us time to repent of?

(Vs.24-25)

Q. WHAT is the message to those who have not taken to heart Satan's deep secrets?

Q. WHAT impact might it have on the need to "*hold on*" to Jesus says to until He comes

Q. **HOW** in knowing what lies ahead in faith, help to keep us faithful in the fight for God given truth now?
