(Revelation 3:7-13)**

Q. DID you ever start out to learn, play or do something you then gave up on and now regret it? **SHARE.**

Q. WHAT is there that you started but did not finish that set you back the most personally or professionally?

Q. HOW ought in knowing the Lord is "*holy and true*" both comfort and challenge us in our own life with Him?

Q. WHAT is the significance of Jesus holding "*the key of David*" and HOW does it relate back to (Isaiah 22:22)

(Vs.8)

Q. WHAT do you think the "*open door*" was that the Lord had set before this church in Philadelphia?

HINT (1 Corinthians 16:9)

Q. WHY did such a church of "*little strength*" make such an impression on the Lord and WHAT should that teach us?

(Vs.9-11)

Q. WHY ought we not to fear or to be intimidated by those who seek to persecute us for what we know to be true?

(Philippians 2:9-11)

Q. HOW can we protect ourselves in the Lord when the day of testing and trials will come?

Q. WHAT is the crown we wouldn't want to lose?

(Vs.12-13)

Q. WHAT lies ahead for the **FAITHFUL TO THE FINISH** church here, and WHAT therefore is *“The Holy Spirit”* saying to us through it?

Q. WHAT are the three things to be written on all those who overcome in the Lord and WHAT do they mean?
