READ: (LUKE 19:28-40 and Hebrews 4:15-16)

Q. HAS anyone ever said or done anything that to your mind was inappropriate and hit all the wrong notes?

Q. HAVE you ever hit the wrong note when it comes to something you said or did and HOW did you know?

(Luke 19:28-40)

Q. WHY did Jesus feel the crowd on Palm Sunday hit the right note in what they were shouting about him, and in WHAT way (Vs.40) did he make it known?

Q. DESCRIBE the different reactions that people had in encountering Jesus on Palm Sunday, and WHY do you think that was?

Q. Earlier in (Luke 12:51 Jesus says he did not come to "*bring peace, but division*") yet now, here in (Vs.38) it refers to Jesus as one who brings peace. HOW can these seemingly contradictory things both be true?

Q. WHAT most stands out to you about the events of Palm Sunday and WHY is that?

(Hebrews 4:15-16)

Q. HOW does Jesus hit the right note when it comes to what we may be going through or struggling with?

Q. HOW does (1 John 2:16) categorise temptation for us and WHAT can learn from Jesus about how we can overcome them? (Matthew 4:1-11)

- Q.** WHAT is the right note we need to hit when we come to God in prayer through our Lord Jesus Christ?
- Q.** HOW does the unmatched life of Jesus as our high priest give us the confidence to seek his help for us?
- Q.** WHAT would the consequences be for us IF Jesus had not overcome temptation and lived without sin?
- Q.** WHAT are the consequences for us as believers IF we sin and fail to hit the right note, in our life before God?
- Q.** ARE there any sins today that now hit the right note with the world but which God has never revoked?
