- **Q.** WHY did Jesus feel the crowd on Palm Sunday hit the right note in what they were shouting about him, and in WHAT way (Vs.40) did he make it known?
- Q. DESCRIBE the different reactions that people had in encountering Jesus on Palm Sunday, and WHY do you think that was?
- **Q.** Earlier in (Luke 12:51 Jesus says he did not come to *"bring peace, but division"* yet now, here in (Vs.38) it refers to Jesus as one who brings peace. HOW can these seemingly contradictory things both be true?
- **Q.** WHAT most stands out to you about the events of Palm Sunday and WHY is that?

(Hebrews 4:15-16)

- **Q.** HOW does Jesus hit the right note when it comes to what we may be going through or struggling with?
- Q. HOW does (1 John 2:16) categorise temptation for us and WHAT can learn from Jesus about how we can overcome them? (Matthew 4:1-11)

- **Q.** WHAT is the right note we need to hit when we come to God in prayer through our Lord Jesus Christ?
- **Q.** HOW does the unmatched life of Jesus as our high priest give us the confidence to seek his help for us?
- **Q.** WHAT would the consequences be for us IF Jesus had not overcome temptation and lived without sin?
- Q. WHAT are the consequences for us as believers IF we sin and fail to hit the right note, in our life before God?
- **Q.** ARE there any sins today that now hit the right note with the world but which God has never revoked?
