- **Q.** WHAT do you think "love and good deeds" refers to?

"Let us not give up ..." (Vs.25)

- **Q.** WHY is it so important for us to meet as the church together as opposed to simply praying by ourselves?
- **Q.** WHY do many believers give up on going to church?
- Q. WHAT should motivate us to be in church?
