Warm up

- 1. As a child did you have a pet? How did it respond when it heard your voice?
- 2. The Green Cross Code is a memorable phrase that carries an important message, what other examples can you think of?

Passage: Read John 10:1-30

Questions relating to passage

- 3. What stands out from the passage about the role of the shepherd?
- 4. How do you feel being compared to a sheep? Being honest, how sheep-like are you?
- 5. What do we learn about Jesus as he refers to himself as the "good shepherd"?
- 6. Reflect on v10 in the light of the Easter story.
- 7. What does Jesus mean when he speaks of "other sheep" (v16)? What does this mean for the composition of his flock?

Further reflection

- 8. In the light of the sermon, think about each of the stages of the Green Cross Code: Stop, Look, Listen, (and Move). The verses listed might help your reflection and discussion:
 - a. Stop: Psalm 46:1, 10-11; Psalm 37:3-7
 - b. Look: Hebrews 12:1-2
 - c. Listen: John 10:27
- 9. What do these look like for you personally?
- 10. Further reflect on the life of Shirley Baptist Church and in particular the coming 6 months. How are you feeling? Is there a temptation to rush ahead, if so, why? What does it mean for you as a church to, Stop, Look and Listen before you move ahead?
