READ (Matthew 6:24-34)

Q. WHAT sticks out most in your own mind about the Coronation of King Charles III and WHY is that?

Q. HOW do you feel about the role of the King in our nation today, and HOW is the principle of (Vs.24) *“you can’t serve two masters”* to be applied here?  
(Romans 13:1ff)

Q. WHAT can King Jesus do that King Charles can’t? In this passage Jesus tells us to **“look”** and to **“consider”** the reality of His sovereign provision.

Q. WHAT are some practical ways that you can frequently do this in your own life?

Q. WHY is it so necessary to seek first God’s Kingdom?

Q. HOW do we go about seeking first God’s Kingdom?

Q. HOW does *“seeking first God’s kingdom and His righteousness”* have the power to disarm the worry in your life?

Q. WHAT is it you worry most about and WHY is it? C.S. Lewis once wrote, *“Don’t let your happiness depend on something that you may lose.”*

Q. HOW might his words apply to what King Jesus said?

Q. HOW do you think our life would look different if we truly decided to seek first the kingdom of God?

Q. WHAT do you think most stops us *“seeking first God’s kingdom and righteousness”*.

Q. HOW is the church to help its members to be more seeking after God and is that something we ourselves are committed to doing?
