# Introduction

- 1. Have you ever been bitten by a mosquito? What was it like? Did you avoid malaria?
- 2. There is a Tanzanian proverb which says, "If you think you are too small to make a difference, try spending the night with a mosquito!"
- 3. Can you think of any positive examples in your life where a small thing has made a big difference?

#### Reading: 2 Kings 4:42-44

- What stories in the NT does this miracle remind you of? (Compare and contrast with John 6:1-14 optional)
- 2. Elisha is described as a "man of God". What does it mean to you to be a man, a woman, a person of God?
- 3. Elisha had a school of 100 prophets. In what ways do you think people are best trained in the use of their spiritual gifts today?
- 4. How were you "trained" in the use of your gifts (for gift lists in the NT please see, for example, Romans 12:6-8, 1 Corinthians 12:7-11, 1 Peter 4:9-11)
- 5. What impresses you about the unnamed man?
- What was the significance of his offering? Exodus 23:16-19

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- 7. Why do you think he came to Elisha rather than going to Jerusalem or Samaria, where there were temples?
- 8. If this story took place during a famine, what significance does it add (see 2 Kings 4:38-41)?

## Application

- 1. As disciples of Jesus, how are we to approach giving today and why? (read 2 Corinthians 9:6-15)?
- 2. What small things can we do which might make a big difference?
- 3. What are some areas of idolatry that we might be prone to today? /

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
