

# **Life Group Notes Sunday 15 October**

## **Harvest - A Little Goes a Long Way**

### **Introduction**

1. Have you ever been bitten by a mosquito? What was it like? Did you avoid malaria?
2. There is a Tanzanian proverb which says, “If you think you are too small to make a difference, try spending the night with a mosquito!”
3. Can you think of any positive examples in your life where a small thing has made a big difference?

### **Reading: 2 Kings 4:42-44**

1. What stories in the NT does this miracle remind you of? (Compare and contrast with John 6:1-14 - optional)
2. Elisha is described as a “man of God”. What does it mean to you to be a man, a woman, a person of God?
3. Elisha had a school of 100 prophets. In what ways do you think people are best trained in the use of their spiritual gifts today?
4. How were you “trained” in the use of your gifts (for gift lists in the NT please see, for example, Romans 12:6-8, 1 Corinthians 12:7-11, 1 Peter 4:9-11)
5. What impresses you about the unnamed man?
6. What was the significance of his offering? Exodus 23:16-19

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7. Why do you think he came to Elisha rather than going to Jerusalem or Samaria, where there were temples?
8. If this story took place during a famine, what significance does it add (see 2 Kings 4:38-41)?

## **Application**

1. As disciples of Jesus, how are we to approach giving today and why? (read 2 Corinthians 9:6-15)?
2. What small things can we do which might make a big difference?
3. What are some areas of idolatry that we might be prone to today? /

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
