Colossians 2:6-10

Introduction:

Do you have a life verse or motto or personal statement that is important to you?

Read Colossians 2:6-7, our church text for the year.

Paul did not start, nor had he visited the Colossian church (1:7, 2:1).

How does he minister to them and “contend” for them?

In what ways can we minister to those we have not seen or met?

What does it mean to receive Christ Jesus as Lord?
How else might we “receive” him?

What do the images “rooted” and “built up” suggest to you?
(You may wish to read Psalm 1:1-3, Jeremiah 17:8 and Luke 6:46-49)

How do you think the Colossians were taught to be strengthened in the faith?
How did this happen?

In what ways might we express thankfulness?

What do you think Paul means by empty and deceptive philosophy?
Is he against academic study?

How might be we “taken captive” by it?

What’s the one thing God wants you to take into the coming week/month/year from this study?
