1. What gifts does Paul highlight in v 1-3 and why, do you think?
2. What dangers lie in being particularly gifted?
3. How are these dangers reduced?
4. Read verses v 4-7 and put your own name in, instead of love. What does this reveal to you?
5. Read them again and where you can put in the opposite e.g. love is not impatient. What further insights does this give, if any?
6. Why do you think Paul refers to tongues, prophesy and knowledge being temporary and in part? v 8-10
7. What analogies does Paul use to describe incompleteness? v 11-12
8. Is Paul saying it's okay not to grow spiritually? Why or why not? (see, for example, Hebrews 5:11-6:2)

9. When will we see face to face? v 12 (see Revelation 22:1-5)
10. Why is love greater than faith or hope? v 13 (see, for example, 1 John 4:7-12)
