## John 13:1-17

### Introduction:

### Study:

Read John 13:1-17

1. What is the significance of Jesus washing his disciples' feet?
2. What might have you expected him to do?
3. Read Mark 10:35-45. How does it relate to John 13:1-17?
4. Why did Jesus only wash their feet and not their head and hands as well, as Peter requested? (Read 1 John 1:6-10)
5. How does this relate to baptism, if at all?
6. What does Jesus call his disciples to do? v 17
7. What does he promise? (See also James 1:22-25)

8. How does this relate to our preaching series on the Beatitudes?

### **Application:**

9. Can you give examples of “foot washing” that already happens at SBC?

10. What kinds of service or “foot-washing” do you find easier (if any!) and which more difficult?

11. Why do you think that might be?

12. Is there any “foot washing” Jesus is calling you to do this week?
