### Who was Thomas?

Thomas (Aramaic) and Didymus (Greek) both mean twin. We don't know who his twin was. Tradition says he went to India and formed the St Thomas Christians in Kerela in South India in AD 52 and was martyred in AD 72. The Mar Thoma church exists in India today and traces it's origins back to Thomas.

- Thomas is known as doubting Thomas. What other qualities did he show? (read Luke 11:16 and John 14:5).

- 5. How does Jesus help Thomas? v27.
- 6. What is the significance of Thomas exclaiming, "My Lord and My God"? v28

- 7. Why did John write this gospel? v29-31
- 8. What do you find the most convincing evidence for the resurrection?
- 9. What is the significance of the resurrection (read 1 Cor 15:12-18)?
- 10. How does this story encourage us into active mission? What might that look like for you?
