- 4. What is the Holy Spirit like? (see for example, John 14:16-17)
- 5. What is his ministry? (see Acts 2:17-21)
- 6. What other passages of Scripture about the Holy Spirit are important to you?
- 7. How can we experience more of the power and presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives? (see, for example, Matth 4:4, Ephesians 6:17, Luke 11:11-13)

8. Joseph Hart, an 18C minister and hymn writer said this in one of his hymns: "True religion is more than notion; something must be known and felt". Why don't we experience more of this? (see, for example, Ephesians 4:30-32)
