Part 4: Breaking New Ground

1. Read Acts 10:1-33. Why is this backstory so important? What had Peter learned from his vision which prepares him to meet Cornelius?
See Acts 10:27-29 and Galatians 3:26-19
2. Read Acts 10:34-48. Now that Peter has the opportunity to tell Cornelius and the others whatever he wants, what does he highlight? What is meant by “Good news of peace” in verse 36?
See Ephesians 2:17
3. The Holy Spirit had fallen on believers in Jerusalem (Acts 2) and in Samaria (Acts 8). Now the Holy Spirit has fallen on Gentiles in Caesarea.
What is Luke emphasising with this?
Acts 1:8
4. How did Jesus want Peter (and now us) to speak of him?
See Acts 10:42-43.
5. Are there any racial, cultural or social barriers to sharing the gospel in your own life?
Have you drawn any boundary lines that shouldn't be there?

6. How can Peter's willingness to learn, understand, and change be a model for us today when facing new perspectives?
7. Have you considered some people too far from God? If so, what are / were those lines?
How does Jesus 'love crush any and all barriers?
8. Are you convinced God has called you to share the truth about Jesus with others?
What are some of your greatest concerns / fears?
What holds you back?
Romans 1:16-17
9. Take some time and pray for Jesus to give you humility and courage.
Pray for the opportunity to speak of him with neighbours, friends, co-workers, family members, or someone specific.
It's a bold prayer and one he might answer in an unexpected way!
