## Isaiah 40:21-31

### Introduction:

Tell us about the first computer you ever owned. What could it do? How does it compare with your computer today?

The theme of our life group notes is God's power.

Read Philippians Isaiah 40:21-31

### Discussion:

1. Who is the most powerful person in the world today that you can think of?
2. How does Isaiah describe God in relation to this person and to powerful people generally? (v21-24)
3. How does Isaiah describe God in relation to creation? (v 25-26)
4. What do you think Israel might have been complaining about? (v 27; read, for example 2 Kings 18:13-16; Isaiah was writing during the reign of King Hezekiah)
5. What is Isaiah's response? (v28)
6. What do you think God's purposes were in allowing Sennacherib to attack Jerusalem? (read 2 Chronicles 32:20-23)

7. What are some of the things we complain about?
8. How might Isaiah answer us?
9. How does God choose to use his infinite power? (v29-31)
10. How do we access God's power and what does that mean in practice? (v31)
