5. How can we support each other in bearing burdens without becoming overly dependent on others for our emotional well-being?
6. Peter warns us to stay alert and watch out for the devil's schemes. What are some strategies to remain spiritually vigilant and resist temptation? Ephesians 6 10-18
7. How can we encourage each other to stand firm in the faith, especially during times of suffering or spiritual attack?
8. Read Colossians 3 v 23-24. How does this encourage you?
