Read Daniel Chapter 6 v 1-23

2. How does Daniel's daily, consistent prayer life show the difference between knowing *about* God and *knowing* God personally?
3. In what ways does your integrity and devotion to God make you stand out or become a target in your workplace or community today?
4. Why is our character so important to God?
5. How did the other administrators use deception and manipulation to get what they wanted (Dan 6:4-7)?
6. When faced with pressure to compromise faith (like Daniel facing the decree), what are some modern-day "decrees" or temptations you face?
7. How can we respond like Daniel when our faith is challenged by rules or societal pressure?
8. What did King Darius's reaction to the decree (Dan 6:14-15) and Daniel's situation reveal about his character and growing faith?

9. How does God's protection of Daniel in the lions' den encourage you to trust Him in your current trials?
10. What does Daniel 6 teach about the sovereignty of God, even when His people suffer for Him?
11. How can your faithfulness to God influence the "King Darius" figures in your life, showing them that your God is real?
12. What specific, actionable step can you take this week to cultivate more boldness or consistency in your faith, inspired by Daniel's example?
